Then there's the charm and historic beauty of the famed London Bridge. With 700 energy-saving LED lights lit up at night in pink and red, this world-famous icon is well suited for a romantic selfie spot.

Local merchants feature Winterfest-related specials, sidewalk displays, live music, a food court and money-saving sales, creating an event that has something for everyone. It's the biggest fundraiser of the year for the Lake Havasu Area Chamber of Commerce.

- 16th Annual Lake Havasu City Rockabilly Reunion, Feb. 16-18, 2024, Lake Havasu State Park, Windsor 4 Ah, rockabilly music, an early style of rock-n-roll. It dates back to the early 1950s in the U.S., especially in the South. As a genre, it blends the sound of Western musical styles, such as country, with that of rhythm and blues, leading to what is considered "classic" rock-n-roll. Come Feb. 16-18 and enjoy two days with cool cats and chicks, retro-fashion, rock-n-roll oldies music and rat-rods. There will be 150 vendors of all types, food, a beer garden and the ever-popular Pin-Up Girl contest. What's more, over 800 cars and motorcycles will be on display. Lake Havasu City is situated on the eastern shore of Lake Havasu on the Colorado River border of California and Arizona. The city was established in 1963 by Robert P. McCulloch, Sr. as a self-sufficient, planned community. Lake Havasu City is located on what is known as "Arizona's West Coast." Driving time is three hours west of Phoenix, 2-1/2 hours south of Las Vegas and

four to five east of the Los Angeles region. As part of the northern and western limits of the Sonoran Desert, Lake Havasu City and the surrounding area feature outstanding biodiversity.

The area attracts 835,000 visitors annually with its historic London Bridge, pristine lake, friendly community, abundant sunshine and annual events, ideal weather and wide range of restaurants and lodging. More than 400 miles of stunning coastline offer exceptional watersports, including fishing, skiing, kayaking and house boating. Visitors can also explore the lake from the beautiful beaches, campsites and hiking trails.
